The Western Allegheny Community Library has social events where attendees bring their own alcohol to consume.

Requirements for BYOB Events

All patrons upon entering the library will be asked for a current identification with their picture and birthdate clearly printed to show proof of legal drinking age. The Library will not allow patrons to attend the event if the patron refuses or does not have proper identification. Staff members have the right to deny access to the event to anyone they think is already impaired by alcohol or other drugs.

The following recommendations apply per person for a typical four to five-hour function:

- Maximum of six twelve ounce cans, bottles of beer, wine coolers, or malt beverages
- No cases, twelve-packs, or other alcohol containers larger than six twelve ounce beers or wine coolers
- No squeeze bottles, water bottles, beer bong, party balls, pitchers, tumblers, or other containers
- No shots, drinking games, or other activities that encourage inappropriate drinking behaviors.

The Western Allegheny Community Library reserves the right to stop consumption of alcohol to any patrons who seem excessively intoxicated and could harm themselves or others. The Library also reserves the right to call the North Fayette Township Police if any patrons become belligerent.
